Gang members in Mexico now using covert skills on Victims

More and More reports of victims of gang members in Mexico are showing that gang members have gained specialized training in covert skills and are using them.

Victims of car jacking's and extortion are reporting that they receive calls from gang members. The gang members are able to tell the victims a complete time line as to their whereabouts, travel time, where they eat and where they live.

This indicates a pattern of intelligence gathering skills, most likely gained from trained law enforcement officers whom have been enlisted by the cartel.

Data gathered on American victims clearly show that very few of the Americans killed or hurt had been given training in personal security techniques.

This leaves victims with little or no resources to protect themselves, very few employees know where to take the specialized personals security training.

Often corporate personnel have little knowledge of providers handling specialized training. But now the world has changed evidence shows that violence will continue to escalate around the world.

In Niger it was estimated that every 10 days a foreign employee was being kidnapped.

Does martial arts' training help?

There are numerous providers of martial arts training programs in the U.S. Evidence shows that these programs by themselves or as initial training programs are a bad idea.

First most of these programs last 1 to 3 days and the providers often have few if any real credentials.

Secondly while martial arts is great for health. Many styles of martial arts are not for real world situations encountered in let's say a carjacking.

Next muscle memory is very important in martial arts training, which these short programs cannot obtain.

It is impractical to expect untrained individuals to respond in such a way as to be able under emergency situations, to protect themselves.

The first rule of a professional trainer is to keep the employee out of these situations. Using force often escalates the chance of being injured.

While martial arts training never hurts.

It should never be used in a way to encourage personnel to use it before attempting nonviolent Response techniques.



Gun scandal creeps closer to the White House

Times reporter Richard Serrano in Washington reports today that at least three officials in the White House were aware of the gun-tracking program that saw hundreds of weapons "walked" into and lost in Mexico, fueling drug-related violence by the ATF.

The officials who received emails about Operation Fast and Furious were Kevin M. O'Reilly, Dan Restrepo and Greg Gatjanis, all national security officials in the Obama administration.

The shocking fact is if a regular citizen were to have allowed guns to go to Mexico he would be prosecuted, but so far only a few of the officials involved have just been reassigned.

Gangsters demand 50 percent of school teachers income.

Hundreds of teachers in fear in the pacific beach area of Acapulco stayed off the job because of threat by gangsters demanding 50 percent of their income. Threats to school teacher's, violence around schools in Monterrey and parents getting shot in Cuidad Juarez. Yet the news in the U.S strangely overlooks reporting the violence. So far violence has primarily targeted Mexican Nationals. Most likely that will soon change. Americans working in Mexico are sure to start becoming victims of kidnapping and ransom requests.

The Government is lying about violence on border including violence on Texas soil. Recently hunters reported being shot at and robbed by Mexican gunmen who crossed the river into the United States.

The Border Patrol has identified those gunmen as Mexican Federal Police Agents, but they said the shooting and robbery were not part of their initial investigation.

"This is a crisis situation on the border and unless a citizen seems to run into it as the hunters did, the government is not really going to tell you about it," Tom Fitton the President of Judicial Watch said.

Texas department of safety Director Steven Mcgraw appearing before a congressional panel stated that the reported statistics on violence on the border don't tell the whole story. He stated that organized crime has proliferated from Brownsville to El Paso. The question is has the government ordered a cover-up and encouraged false statistics. Incursions are happening at an alarming rate.
